- Submit appropriate documentation. Provide current documentation of your disability and the disability-related need for any specific accommodation(s) being requested. Current documentation is necessary for verification purposes and to determine reasonable accommodations. Please use our documentation guidelines and verification forms to assist in the submission of documentation.
- 3. Schedule and attend a Student Welcome Meeting. Upon receipt of the online application and supporting documentation, OAE will reach out to schedule a meeting to discuss the impact, nature and functional limitations of your disability; determine eligibility for reasonable accommodations; and discuss processes, policies and procedures.
