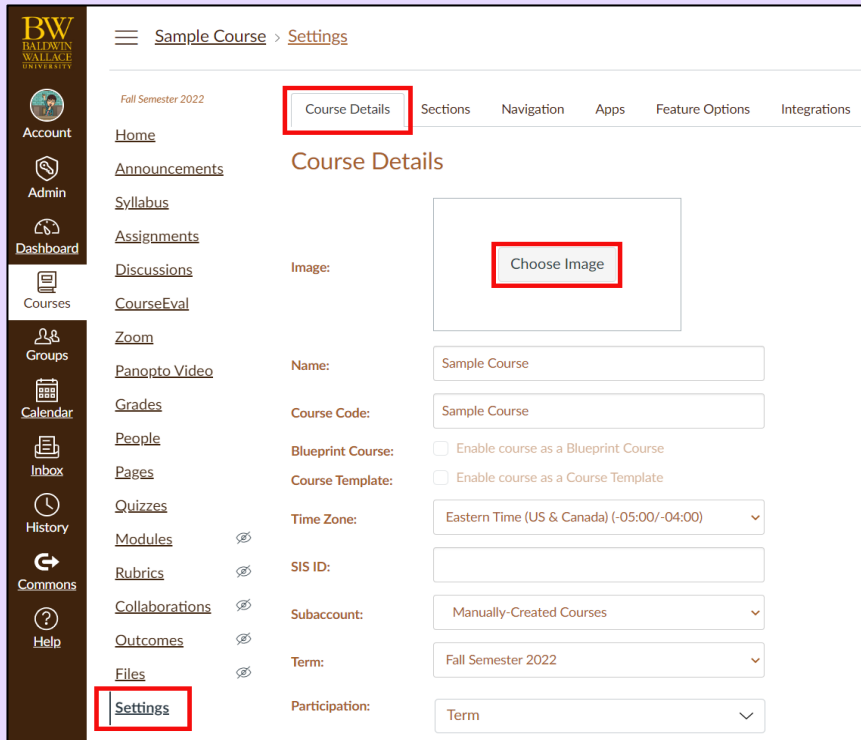


# Adding an Image to Your Course Card in Canvas

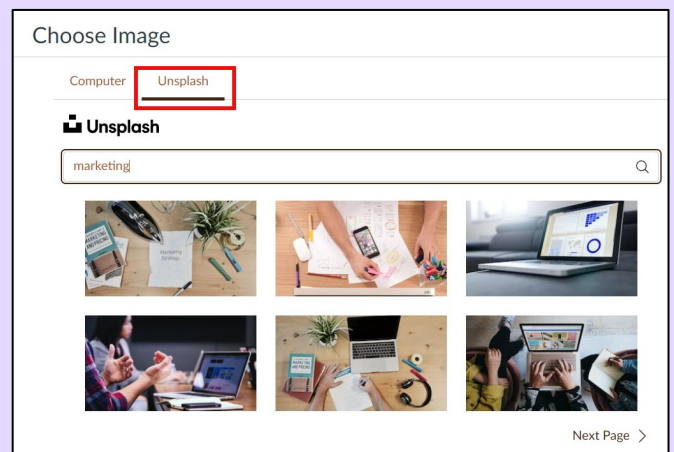
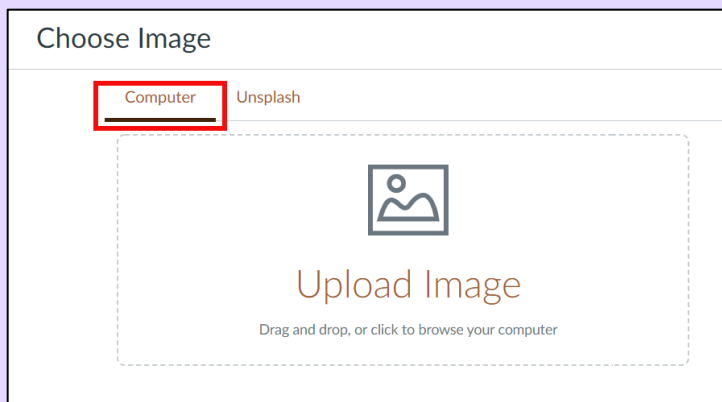
On your Canvas dashboard, you will see a “course card” for each course displayed in a different color. You can add an image to the course card and change the color.

1. Open any course. From the course navigation menu, click on “Settings.”



From the Course Details tab, click the “Choose Image” button in the Image box.

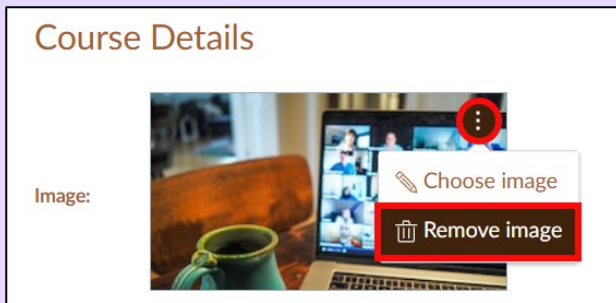
2. Two options will appear on the tabs: **Computer** or **Unsplash**.
  - a. Computer: Add your own image (such as an image of your textbook)
  - b. Unsplash: Pre-loaded images you can use. Search by title/topic.



3. After selecting an image from either source, click “Update Course Details” at the bottom of the page!

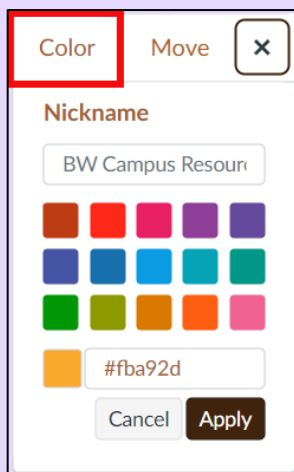
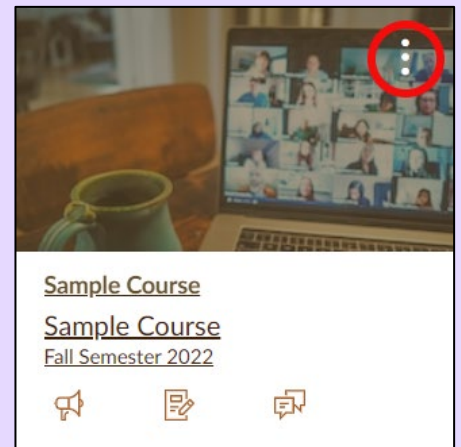
**Update Course Details**

- Once you've selected an image you can change it at any time by clicking the 3 dots.



**NOTE:** Don't forget to click "Update Course Details" at the bottom of the page any time you make changes.

- Returning to your course dashboard, you can see there is now an image on your course card.
- To change the COLOR of this image, click the 3 dots. From the "Color" tab, you can choose one of the default colors or put in a hex code for another color. Click "Apply." **NOTE:** The color you choose is what YOU will see. Students can change their own course card colors to help differentiate between what they see. Click the "Move" tab to re-order or unfavorite a course.



The colors you choose for your course cards integrate with your calendar. This gives quick reminders to faculty OR students about what is due for each of their courses.
